ANÁLISIS GLOBAL

Perfil de los participantes

El evento «*Electricity for Industrialisation*» reunió a un grupo multidisciplinar de representantes de organismos públicos, empresas privadas, asociaciones empresariales, entidades financieras, centros de investigación, universidades y organizaciones vinculadas al desarrollo energético e industrial de Canarias y Mauritania.

Entre los asistentes se encontraban directivos, responsables de desarrollo de negocio, ingenieros, consultores, representantes institucionales y especialistas técnicos, configurando un foro con un elevado nivel de conocimiento y capacidad de decisión.

La diversidad de perfiles favoreció un intercambio de experiencias desde diferentes perspectivas, permitiendo abordar los retos de la industrialización y de la transición energética desde un enfoque integral.

Motivaciones para participar

Del análisis de los formularios se desprende que los participantes acudieron al encuentro con una clara vocación de colaboración y de generación de oportunidades de negocio.

Las principales motivaciones identificadas fueron:

- Establecer relaciones comerciales y estratégicas entre Canarias y Mauritania.
- Conocer proyectos energéticos e industriales en desarrollo.
- Compartir experiencias y buenas prácticas.
- Identificar oportunidades de inversión y cooperación internacional.
- Presentar la actividad y capacidades de sus respectivas organizaciones.
- Favorecer la creación de alianzas entre empresas e instituciones.
- Impulsar iniciativas relacionadas con la transición energética y la industrialización.

En conjunto, las respuestas reflejan un elevado interés por fortalecer la cooperación empresarial e institucional entre ambos territorios.

- Innovación tecnológica aplicada a la energía.

Financiación e institucional

También se identificó una importante presencia de entidades capaces de facilitar el desarrollo de inversiones mediante instrumentos financieros, programas públicos de apoyo a la internacionalización y mecanismos de colaboración público-privada.

Oportunidades de colaboración identificadas

Las respuestas de los participantes ponen de manifiesto numerosas oportunidades de cooperación entre organizaciones canarias y mauritanas.

Entre ellas destacan:

- Desarrollo conjunto de proyectos de energías renovables.
- Participación en iniciativas de hidrógeno verde.
- Colaboración en ingeniería y consultoría técnica.
- Formación y transferencia de conocimiento.
- Desarrollo de infraestructuras energéticas.
- Cooperación logística y portuaria.
- Internacionalización de empresas.
- Suministro industrial.
- Participación conjunta en proyectos financiados internacionalmente.

Asimismo, se aprecia un interés compartido por consolidar a Canarias como plataforma logística, empresarial y tecnológica para el desarrollo de proyectos en África Occidental.

Conclusiones

La información recopilada mediante los formularios refleja el elevado nivel técnico y estratégico de los participantes que formaron parte del encuentro.

Las respuestas evidencian un interés generalizado por establecer nuevas relaciones de cooperación, compartir conocimiento y participar en proyectos vinculados a la transición energética, la industrialización y el desarrollo económico sostenible.

La diversidad de organizaciones representadas permitió generar un espacio de diálogo especialmente enriquecedor, en el que confluyeron administraciones públicas, empresas, centros de investigación, universidades y entidades financieras con capacidad para impulsar iniciativas conjuntas.

El análisis realizado confirma que la mesa redonda constituyó un foro de alto valor para identificar oportunidades de colaboración entre Canarias y Mauritania, reforzando el papel de ambos territorios como socios estratégicos en el desarrollo de proyectos energéticos e industriales.
